Comments on this criterion (optional): Almost all SLOs are student focused and written in terms understandable to students but more descriptive action verbs or application context could be included, e.g. "produce" could be enhanced with 'apply industry standard announcing skills to produce professional quality..."

Also, some classes have the same SLOs. It seems there should be some distinction between outcomes of different courses.

Deficiencies are addressed in the recommendations and summary. SLO #1 for TVR 7 could be streamlined by leaving the details in the rubric.

Comments on this criterion (optional): The assessment for SLO #1 for TVR 7 seems to measure only one aspect of stated outcome. The rest of the assessments seem to align well with stated outcomes.
